

BBQG “Joyce F. Blasi” & “Luci Smith” Scholarship

The Blasi and Smith scholarships are funded by the Brazos Bluebonnet Quilt Guild, a local group that promotes the appreciation of quilts and quilt making. The guild awards these scholarships to pursue higher education in the visual arts, family and life sciences, career tech, or a related field at an accredited college or technical school.

The scholarships are for one year only in the amount of \$1,000, paid directly to the college. At least two awards will be given to applicants from the pool of graduating high school seniors in Bryan/College Station high schools, including private schools and home-schooled students. Each scholarship winner will also receive a throw quilt made by a guild member.

Award recipients are required to mail in a short form providing college address and contact information, within 30 days of the start of classes at their chosen college before funds are disbursed.

Application consists of:

- The completed attached form.
- A transcript which includes grade point average or class rank.
- ACT or SAT results.
- Teacher recommendation letter (1).
- Photographs or copies of artwork, or directions to a website displaying artwork (photographs and artwork will not be returned). Family or life science projects (e.g., 4-H projects) should be summarized on a separate page.

Selection is based equally on:

- Intended major in college.
- Grades, course difficulty, and class rank.
- Family financial need, based on parents' employment and size of family.
- Quality of artwork and/or projects.
- Letters of recommendation.
- Community service activities & extra-curricular activities.

Completed Scholarship Applications must be post marked no later than **March 15**.

Be sure to allow for slow postal service and be sure adequate postage is attached, as this could cause a delay in delivery past the deadline.
